Project Description:	This project will construct a three-building academic complex totaling 126,449 asf for selected programs of the College of Letters and Science and the Gevirtz Graduate School of Education that will, in conjunction with the overall campus "space plan," provide space to accommodate existing enrollments and projected growth. In addition to the instruction and research space funded with State funds, gift funds will provide additional instruction and research space, including specialized facilities such as a film theatre, Autism Clinic space, demonstration rooms, and associated support space. The project as a whole will provide new classrooms and seminar rooms (2,559 asf), class laboratories and support (21,145 asf), research and scholarly activity space (22,469 asf), clinic space (5,121 asf), demonstration space (5,500 asf), a film theatre (7,309 asf), and office and support space (62,346 asf). The campus will be able to mitigate the space needs of at least 21 academic departments, through the new space and the reassignment of released space.
