Project Description:	The existing Santa Barbara library facility is extremely overcrowded, cannot accommodate new technology, and lacks sufficient student instructional support and study space. This project will construct approximately 45,000 asf of new library facilities and renovate and seismically upgrade existing library facilities on the Santa Barbara campus. This project will provide additional collections space and additional reading and computing workspace for users, consolidate library operations for greater operational efficiency, and address seismic and life safety deficiencies in the existing buildings.
