Project Description:	This project will construct and equip a new 91,400 asf building, Biological Sciences Unit 3, on the Irvine campus that will provide space to meet projected enrollment growth in the School of Biological Sciences. The building will provide space for research laboratories and associated support space, faculty and administrative office space, and animal space for the School of Biological Sciences; a 400-seat general assignment lecture hall; and additional space for the School of Humanities on an interim basis that ultimately will be used to support growth in academic support programs.
