Project Description:	This project will provide renovations to approximately 35,000 asf of space in Mayer Hall and construct a 45,000 asf addition to provide modern instruction and research facilities for the Department of Physics. This project will address existing and anticipated enrollment growth needs of the campus, including the Physical Sciences programs. The project will construct new instructional laboratories in Mayer Hall, releasing space in an existing building for other campus programs; provide research laboratories, and office, administrative, and scholarly activity space; and provide specialized facilities, including a high bay laboratory. In addition, the building infrastructure in existing Mayer Hall will be upgraded.
